# JOINING INSTRUCTIONS

Greenland & Wild Labrador, September 17 – October 1, 2023

### MANDATORY BRIEFING & WELCOME DESK — SEPTEMBER 16, 2023

Welcome to Toronto!

On September 16, Adventure Canada will have a **mandatory guest briefing at 18:00 EDT in EDT the Gateway Ballroom** at the Sheraton Gateway Hotel located in Terminal 3 of Toronto Pearson Airport. Adventure Canada staff and signs will be posted in the lobby to assist in directing you to the briefing location. Attendance at this briefing is required, as we will be going over safety embarkation procedures, the departure details of our northbound charter flight, and other important details for your voyage.

Prior to this mandatory briefing, there will be a Welcome Desk set up outside of the Gateway Ballroom from **16:00-18:00 EDT**. During this time, please feel free to come by to meet your fellow travellers and check in. Here you will complete a health declaration form, receive your name tag, baggage tags, and expedition jacket Kindy note that dinner is the travellers' responsibility for this day.

In the event of a delay or emergency during transit, please contact the Adventure Canada emergency number promptly to provide the team with immediate notification.

#### NORTHBOUND CHARTER FLIGHT & EMBARKATION — SEPTEMBER 17, 2023

We will meet in the mid-morning on September 17 for the northbound charter flight to Kangerlussuaq, Greenland. The flight check-in process and time will be provided at the mandatory briefing. Flight time is approximately 4.5 hours, and a meal will be served on board. Please keep your passport, personal items, medication, and wet weather gear in your carry-on or daypack.

Once we arrive in Kangerlussuaq, there will be a bus transfer to the pier where we will take a Zodiac ride to the *Ocean Endeavour*. This Zodiac transfer may be wet due to sea or weather conditions and any personal valuables such as electronics, may want to be placed in a waterproof or water-repellent bag.

You will need your passport for identification and security purposes as you embark the *Ocean Endeavour*. No tickets are provided for this voyage. Please note, your luggage may be screened by security before you board the ship.

Once all on board the *Ocean Endeavour* we will begin our Greenland & Wild Labrador adventure!



#### **DISEMBARKATION — OCTOBER 1, 2023**

At the completion of our voyage, we will arrive in St. John's, Newfoundland and disembark the *Ocean Endeavour* in the morning. Adventure Canada offers the following one-time, complimentary transfers immediately following disembarkation on October 1:

- a) Transfer to Delta St. John's Hotel.
- b) Transfer to St. John's International Airport (YYT): onward flights should be for any time after **13:00 NDT**.

For those not taking either of the above transfers, kindly note you will be responsible for arranging your **own transportation** from St. John's Harbour. Taxis may be available for your hire.
