# JOINING INSTRUCTIONS

High Arctic Explorer, August 5 – August 16, 2023

#### MANDATORY BRIEFING & WELCOME DESK — AUGUST 4, 2023

Welcome to Ottawa!

On August 4, Adventure Canada will have a **mandatory guest briefing at 18:00 EDT in the Adam Room** at the Fairmont Château Laurier (1 Rideau St, Ottawa). Adventure Canada staff and signs will be posted in the lobby to assist in directing you to the briefing location. Attendance at this briefing is required, as we will be going over safety embarkation procedures, the departure details of our northbound charter flight, and other important details for your voyage.

Prior to this mandatory briefing, there will be a Welcome Desk set up outside of the Adam Room from **16:00-18:00 EDT**. During this time, please feel free to come by to meet your fellow travellers and check in. Here you will complete a health declaration form, receive your name tag, baggage tags, and expedition jacket. Kindly note that all meals are the travellers' responsibility for this day.

In the event of a delay or emergency during transit, please contact the Adventure Canada emergency number promptly to provide the team with immediate notification.

### NORTHBOUND CHARTER FLIGHT & EMBARKATION — AUGUST 5, 2023

We will meet in the morning on August 5 for the transfer to our northbound charter flight to Resolute, Nunavut. The meeting location and exact time of the transfer will be provided at the mandatory briefing. Flight time is approximately 6 hours, and a meal will be served on board. Please keep your passport, personal items, medication, and wet weather gear in your carry-on or daypack.

Once we arrive in Resolute, there will be a bus transfer to the pier where we will take a Zodiac ride to the *Ocean Endeavour*. This Zodiac transfer may be wet due to sea or weather conditions and any personal valuables such as electronics, may want to be placed in a waterproof or water-repellent bag.

You will need your passport for identification and security purposes as you embark the *Ocean Endeavour*. No tickets are provided for this voyage. Please note, your luggage may be screened by security before you board the ship.

Once all on board the Ocean Endeavour we will begin our High Arctic adventure!



#### DISEMBARKATION & SOUTHBOUND CHARTER FLIGHT — AUGUST 16, 2023

Upon concluding our voyage, we will reach Kangerlussuaq, Greenland, and disembark the *Ocean Endeavour*. We will have a Zodiac ride to the pier followed by a bus transfer to the airport for our southbound charter flight to Toronto, Ontario.

Flying time is approximately 4.5 hours and a meal will be served. It will be a late-morning arrival to Toronto Pearson International Airport (YYZ) and guests will be responsible for making their way home from Toronto independently.

Kindly note, we advise not booking onward travel before 17:00 EDT for guests departing Toronto on this day to minimize the risk of missed connections that may result from potential delays.
