JOINING INSTRUCTIONS

Iceland to Greenland, July 13 – July 25, 2023

EMBARKATION - JULY 13, 2023:

Welcome to Reykjavík!

Please stop by the Adventure Canada Welcome Desk located at the **Miðbakki Pier on July 13, 2023** any time between **10:00-14:00 GMT.** The pier is located on the waterfront in downtown Reykjavík, at the intersection of Miðbakki and Geirsgata (<u>5326+28P, Geirsgata,</u> <u>101 Reykjavík</u>). Adventure Canada team members will check you in, and help you complete a health declaration form. Here you will also receive your name and baggage tags. Once you check in, you are welcome to leave your tagged luggage with the Adventure Canada team and head out to explore the beautiful city of Reykjavík!

At **15:00 GMT** please make your way back to Miðbakki Pier to begin boarding the *Ocean Endeavour*. Please keep your passport, personal items, and medication in your carry-on or daypack. Your passport will be needed for identification and security purposes as you embark the *Ocean Endeavour*. No ticket, confirmation number, or further instruction is provided for this voyage. Your luggage may be screened by security before you board the ship.

All guests must be on board the *Ocean Endeavour* no later than **16:00 GMT**, as the ship will be departing at that time. It is the traveller's responsibility to board in time for departure. We ask that you please ensure your timely arrival to avoid any possibility of missing your scheduled trip. Once on board, we will have our guest orientation followed by dinner. Kindly note that breakfast and lunch are the travellers' responsibility on this day. You will receive your expedition jacket and complimentary water bottle once on board.

DISEMBARKATION & SOUTHBOUND CHARTER FLIGHT – JULY 25, 2023

Upon concluding our voyage, we will reach Kangerlussuaq, Greenland, and disembark the *Ocean Endeavour*. We will have a Zodiac ride to the pier followed by a bus transfer to the airport for our southbound flight to Toronto, Ontario.

Flying time is approximately 4.5 hours and a meal will be served. It will be a late-morning arrival to Toronto Pearson International Airport (YYZ) and guests will be responsible for making their way home from Toronto independently.

Kindly note, we advise not booking onward travel before 17:00 EDT for guests departing Toronto on this day to minimize the risk of missed connections that may result from potential delays.
