## PRE-VOYAGE INFORMATION:

**Arrival:** Guests will need to be in Toronto in time for the mandatory briefing at 18:00 EDT on August 26, 2024. We also encourage you to stop by the Welcome Desk prior to the briefing. More details about the briefing will be provided in your final package approximately one month prior to departure.

Optional Pre-Trip Hotel: Sheraton Gateway Hotel. Available to book for check in on August 25 and August 26, 2024.



**Welcome Desk & Briefing:** The Adventure Canada Welcome Desk will be available at the Sheraton Gateway Hotel on August 26, 2024, between 16:00-18:00 EDT. During this time, please ensure you stop by to meet your fellow travellers and check in to receive your name tag, baggage tags, and expedition jacket. The mandatory briefing will then begin at 18:00 EDT and will provide the information needed for the charter flight and embarkation the next day.

**Charter Flight & Embarkation:** On August 27, 2024, we will fly from Toronto Pearson International Airport (YYZ) to Kangerlussuaq Airport (SFJ), where we will transfer to the *Ocean Endeavour* and begin our adventure!

Further details regarding the briefing and charter flights will be provided in your final package approximately one month prior to departure.



## **POST-VOYAGE INFORMATION:**

**Disembarkation & Charter Flight:** On September 12, 2024, we will disembark in Kugluktuk, Nunavut. We will make our way to Kugluktuk Airport (YCO) where we will fly to Yellowknife Airport (YZF).

**Transfer:** Following the charter flight, there will be an optional complimentary transfer available for all guests from the airport to the Explorer Hotel Yellowknife on September 12, 2024. Further details about this transfer will be provided by the on-board team near the end of the voyage.

**Departure:** While we anticipate a mid-day arrival, we strongly advise booking your onward travel for September 13, 2024, or later, to not only minimize the chances of missed connections but also to provide you with added flexibility and peace of mind. Additionally, we recommend considering fully flexible or refundable flight tickets in case of unforeseen delays.



## **Hotel Booking Instructions and Terms & Conditions**

Please note, reservations are subject to availability and the option to book hotel nights through Adventure Canada is only available up to 30 days prior to your trip's departure.
