- **Canadian Whale Institute** (canadianwhaleinstitute.ca): The CWT's mandate is to conduct scientific research and use those data to further the conservation and stewardship of marine mammals.
- **Canadian Wildlife Federation** (cwf-fcf.org): The CWF mission is to conserve and inspire the conservation of Canada's wildlife and habitats for the use and enjoyment of all.
