A Journey through the Galápagos – March 24 to April 1, 2027

Pre-Voyage Itinerary:

Day 1 – March 24

Upon arrival in Quito, Ecuador (UIO), a transfer will take you to the Casa Gangotena Hotel, where a welcome desk awaits. An expedition team member will be available to greet you. Please note that meals on this day are at your own expense, but your overnight stay is included.

Day 2 – March 25

After breakfast, we'll transfer to Mariscal Sucre International Airport (UIO) for our flight to Isla Baltra airport (GPS). Upon arrival, we'll board *La Pinta* and settle in for our Galápagos voyage.

Post-Voyage Itinerary:

Day 9 – April 1

After breakfast on board, we disembark on Isla Baltra and head to the local airport (GPS). Guests flying home today will return to Quito (UIO), where you should plan onward arrangements for the evening to allow flexibility.

If you're joining the Machu Picchu extension, your journey continues through Guayaquil (GYE) to Lima, Peru. Guests are responsible for booking the GYE–LIM flight, either independently or through Adventure Canada—contact Client Services or your travel advisor for assistance.

- Guests are responsible for arranging their own flights to and from Quito, Ecuador (UIO). We strongly recommend booking fully flexible, refundable tickets to accommodate potential delays.
