Small Group Questions

1. The Holy Spirit is a seal of salvation on me. Have I been made secure? If so, how does this security show?
2. Baptism is the thing that gives us our identity; that says we are in the family. What are the differences between water baptism and Spirit baptism? Have I been baptized both internally and externally?
3. What are some benefits of being identified as belonging to God's family?
4. The Holy Spirit makes me alive! Stone hearts cannot feel God's touch so God gives me a new heart. Have I experienced the Holy Spirit's tender touch? How did it change me?
5. The Holy Spirit convicts me, showing me my need. What is my need? While the gospel changes my life, it does not solve all my temporal problems. Why not? What difference does it make in facing my temporal problems?

- Am I grieving the Holy Spirit? Is there anything that the Holy Spirit has been convicting me of lately - a place I go, an activity I do, a pattern of thinking I engage in? Spend some time in repentance, and make a plan for how you are going to stop grieving the Holy Spirit.
