Small Group Questions

1. The Holy Spirit is a seal of salvation on me, and working in me to set me apart for God. How does his work in me show through the nine fruits of the Spirit? (Love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control.) Share with each other, the following:
What are three I have rocking?
What are three I am just okay on?
What are three I really need to have God help me grow in?
2. What are some ramifications of the statement , “Sanctification is for believers only.”
3. In what specific ways is my eagerness for the Word of God evident? (Is it just a check mark or does it penetrate my heart?)
4. Am I ready to receive “solid food”? What do I need to do to ramp up how I receive the Word of God?
5. What is the difference in “coming to church to get assurance” and “coming to church to express assurance?”
6. “I am saved!” “I still sin.” How does the conflict between these two realities express itself in us?

- Is there a specific circumstance that challenges my expression of the fruit of the Spirit? Ask for prayer for growth and transformation in that circumstance.
