Warming Up

1. Rahab's dilemma: If you were hiding Israelite spies in your home and guards came to your door asking if you were hiding spies there, what would you do and why?

Digging In: When you're faith-filled you...

...accept the crises as coming from the Lord

2. What was the crisis the Lord used to bring you to himself?
3. If you are currently undergoing a crisis, what do you think the Lord is trying to draw your attention to?
4. "God judged her ultimately by her enduring faith, and not by her lie." Discuss the implications of this statement for how God judges us and others around us.

...acknowledge the certainty of who he is

5. What are we saying about God when we acknowledge the certainty of who he is?

...assume the risk of following him

6. What risks are you taking currently by following Christ?
7. Pastor Todd predicted that a day is soon coming when we will be asked to decide if we follow Christ, and if we decide to follow Christ our losses will be great (Matt 16:24-25). When that moment comes what will you decide? Discuss the pros and cons of the different responses to the decision.

...act on what you have professed

8. Discuss the connection between a person's profession and action. How does a person's profession influence their action? How does a person's action reveal their profession?

...acquire the benefits of believing

9. What are the benefits of believing in God and acting in faith? What are the benefits of being a faith-filled everyday hero?

10. What is God asking you to do for him? What is your scarlet cord? Is it risking something for him? Taking on some service? Walking away from something that's hindering your faith?
