A Growing Person

- We used terms like ‘quality’ and ‘quantity’ to describe spiritual health. Following that example, how has your spiritual health been in the last three months? How would one recognize some sickness creeping in?

A Gracious Person (Colossians 2:6-7)

- A gracious person demonstrates the value they place on others in the way they talk to them or about them. What are some ways you’ve spoken with grace to people at your home, work or school?
- Grace is expressed through the continual forgiveness of people who hurt, bother or offend you. How are you doing with forgiveness as an expression of grace in these situations?

A Grateful Person (Ephesians 4:32)

- Have you ever gone out of your way to express gratitude to a person? What did you do for them?
- Has anyone ever gone out of his or her way to express gratitude to you? How did you respond or change after this?

A Generous Person (Proverbs 11:24-25)

“A lack of generosity, stinginess, is really incompatible with the life of a genuine disciple of Christ. The unstoppable disciple of Jesus finds ways to be generous and thereby exemplifies the generosity of Jesus toward us.” – Pastor Todd Dugard

- Are you aware of any ways God has blessed you (not necessarily financially) in response to your generosity in the past? Why do you think God responds this way to your generous activity?
- God measures the value of our gifts and our service in comparison to our “all”(Mark 12:41-44) How do we know when we are being generous and not simply contributing a little out of our abundance to extra time or resources?

A Glorifying Person (2 Corinthians 3:18)

- When you interact with others or talk about Jesus to people who don’t believe, how do you share his glory with them?
