Life is so often marked by tears... (126:1a, 5a, 6a)

- Do tears take us closer to or further from God's heart?
- How can a person know whether their sorrow is based in circumstance or consequence?

...but God has brought about a great reversal of fortune (126:2-4, 5b, 6b)

- Do you think God has ever lifted you out of hard circumstances or consequences? What's that feel like? Did it change the way you sing to him?
- Why might God be holding back greater restorative work in your life?

...by doing unimaginably great things for us. (126:1b)

- What are some amazing things you'd love to see the Lord do for you?
- What makes it hard to believe it could happen in reality?
- How do you pray in faith for these unimaginable things to happen?
