Dig In!

I am a God-glorifying Christian when...

My righteousness displays his glory (3:7-11)

- Where does righteousness (conformity to God's commands) tend to set us apart from others who don't believe?
- How can we help each other handle the isolation that sometimes accompanies a commitment to righteousness? (Psalm 1:1-3)

My confidence displays his glory (3:12-16)

- Describe your confidence level with the following activities: Unapologetic Preaching? Unceasing Prayer? Unashamed Worship? Unafraid Witness?
- How can we increase our confidence in these things so God's glory comes through us?

My freedom displays his glory (3:17)

- What fears, bitter feelings, or regrets about past sin may be holding you back from displaying more of God's glory?
- Are you free from the shackles of other's expectations for you?
- How can our group keep from falling into deception about our spiritual progress?

My transformation displays his glory (3:18)

- How are you a better reflector of God's image now than before you began submitting to the Holy Spirit on a daily basis? Tell a transformation story if you have one appropriate to share in this setting.
