

**All the People Rejoice**

**Luke 13:10-21 – Pastor Todd Dugard**

*What is a good thing happening in your life right now?*

Dig In!

**You'll know that the kingdom of God has come to where you are when... (v. 18-21)**

**The Lord is getting credit for what's going on (v. 17c)**

- What's the problem with failing to recognize God's hand in the good that happens in the world?
- What do you do and say to give credit to the Lord for the good things that happen to you?

**The believers are rejoicing in it all (v. 17b)**

- What's the atmosphere of the worship experience at your home? (Acts 2:42) How do you get more rejoicing going on outside of worship service times?
- Talk about times when God has let you feel wonder and amazement. How did you express the awe that springs from the genuine, powerful, supernatural work of God?

**The religious types are being put in their place (v. 14-17a)**

- Why is it so difficult to see our own hypocrisy? How could we learn about our own hypocrisy before it brings us shame and disgrace?

*"Listen, religious types fret about chairs, about styles and colours, about liturgies, about particular ministry forms, titles & positions, about theological systems; they're rigid about words, policies and history. They want things comfortable and the same. And none of that is going to be us or, I swear before God, we'll shut it down."*

**The hurting are being healed and helped (v. 10-13)**

- Jesus brought the kingdom as a gift. How should hurting people's lives improve when you are present and acting in the power of God?
