Dig In!

More freedom experienced (14:1-6)

We are living in a culture described as "irreligious and without repentance". People are throwing off authority and structure in favour of spirituality on their own terms.

- Why do you think self-defined spirituality appeals to people?
- How can you use your freedom in Christ to make more of him and less of ourselves?

More humility embraced (14:7-11)

It's hard to shake the pride filled notion that we're entitled to special treatment for exceptional moral behaviour. This can give people in church the incorrect sense that they deserve Salvation.

- How do you continue to build a sense of humility before God into your daily life?

More compassion exhibited (14:12-14)

"It isn't that some are called to serve the least of these but that we all are. Jesus will ask us all about this." – Todd Dugard

- What are practical ways you can serve "the least worthy" this month?

More grace evidenced (14:15-24)

- How does seeing yourself as someone who is invited last to the party help develop the sense of God's grace on your life?
- How have you practically extended the invitation to come to Jesus to other "misfits"?
