Made to be gracious (2 Corinthians 12:9 and Ephesians 4:29)

- Ephesians 4:17-5:2 highlights five areas for us to dispense grace. A quick check up is required: Truth embodied speech with care and concern? Anger controlled so that most stuff just rolls off your back? Work performed without short cuts? Encouragement delivered regularly through affirmation rather than criticism or gossip? Forgiveness granted so that matters are no longer brought up with the person, with others, or internally? WHAT MAKES THIS STUFF SO HARD FOR SOME PEOPLE TO DO?

Made to be generous (3:12-16)

- Are you happy with how you've handled your commitments to help others and our church during this campaign?
- Regardless of your generosity in the past, where are the new areas for you to express generosity now?

Made to be growing (2 Corinthians 5:10 and 2 Peter 1:3-10)

- 2 Peter 1:3-10 – Here is a list of facets of a maturing Christian. Which of these have you been diligent to develop as instructed from 2 Peter 1:3-10 (ESV)?
- Why is maturity a measure of several points of character and not just about belief, or goodness?

Made to be grateful (2 Corinthians 4:7-15)

- Why can it be difficult to express gratitude? How do you know when an expression of gratitude is affected by pride vs distraction on something else?

Made to be glorifying (2 Corinthians 3:18)

- How are you a better reflector of God's image now than two years ago (when we began this campaign)?
