If you've made the "classic mistake", what did you learn from experiencing the consequences?

What does faithfulness look like as you wait for God to fulfill a promise in your life?

One of the last illustrations Charles gave was of someone who studied the car manual but neglected the experience of actually driving the car. How do we avoid doing this with the Bible and Jesus?

What can you do this week to make sure you are turning truth into experience?
