GROUP DISCUSSION

1. God's mercy is so great you may sooner drain the sea of its water, or deprive the sun of its light, or make space too narrow than diminish the great mercy of God. - C.H. Spurgeon
 - Does it bring you comfort to see the far reach and depth of Christ's mercy (i.e. to the most undeserving, or those disregarded by society, etc.)?
 - How does Christ's mercy reveal your need for him?
2. Upon being called by Jesus, Bartimaeus took his coat off and jumped to his feet to meet him.
 - What does it teach us about coming to Jesus with nothing to offer but in faith alone?
 - What are some of the common lies or loud noises that you sometimes allow to distract or discourage you from trusting Jesus in life?
3. Following his encounter with Jesus, Bartimaeus chose to make Jesus' way his way.
 - How passionate are you about following Jesus? Do you prioritize your walk with Jesus over other things?
 - What are some things you could/should do as a Life Group to encourage one another more in this?
