

## Is anything impossible for our God? Yes! Of course!

Here's a few: he can't sin or tempt us to sin; he can't lie or change his mind. Even what he can't do is good news for us. Here's why:



Colossians 1:12-14 says: [12] we give thanks to the Father, who has qualified you to share in the inheritance of the saints in light. [13] He has delivered us from the domain of darkness and transferred us to the kingdom of his beloved Son, [14] in whom we have redemption, the forgiveness of sins.

If you are in Christ, this is true of you and can never be changed. God can't lie or change his mind! He:

- Qualified you to share in the inheritance
- Delivered you out of the domain of darkness
- Transferred you into the kingdom of Jesus, his beloved Son
- Redeemed you
- Has forgiven your sins

He said it—he cannot and will not take it back. Even on your worst days of sin, fear, and failure. Your redemption can never be undone.

## Response:

Here's one suggested response: Take one thing God has said about you (i.e. forgiveness, adoption, new creation), turn it over in your mind, and then tell someone.

Share the GOOD NEWS of what our God cannot do or take back!
