

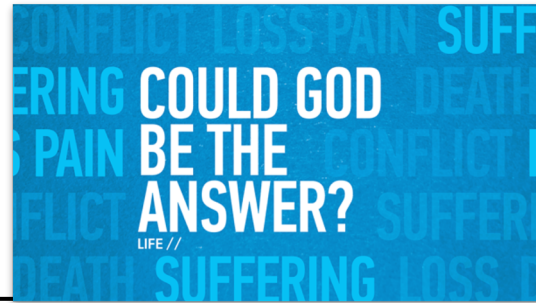

GROUP DISCUSSION

1. In what ways do believers struggle along, settle for less, and have a lesser view of our Saviour and Lord? Why don't some Christians want more?
2. READ Colossians 1:9-14. How does the passage we're studying in this short series (1:15-23) relate to this first section of the letter?
3. How does the image of God in us change the way we see issues like gender, marriage, sexuality, race, etc.?
4. If we acknowledge that, "in him all things hold together" (1:17b), what does that do to our confidence? How does it help our faith?
5. Being in the image of God also speaks to our engagement in the life of the church. We are one body, as Paul explains. What could you do to help our church have a greater sense of being one body?
6. Knowing you are loved by Christ, how does that change things for you? Do you struggle to know you're loved? What would it take for you to fully realize the depth of his love for you?
