3 – Missio Dei: Made for Mission for God

Colossians 1:23



1. Which of the big three questions of life (*Who am I? Where am I going? Why am I here?*) was foremost in your heart and mind when you came to faith in Christ?
2. Do you know people who think that they are saved simply because they made a decision when they were younger but who show no evidence of being a Christian now? Based on God's Word alone, are they saved? What Scriptures help us know this?
3. We looked at the words "stable" and "steadfast" in 1:23b. If these words do not describe your Christian life, what would it take to change that? In what ways could you look more intently at Jesus and find stability and steadfastness?
4. Review the definition of hope (based on John's Piper's) that Pastor Todd shared; "A Christian's hope is the confident expectation and desire for good things in the future grounded in the person and work of Jesus Christ." How does having this hope change how we view and act amid difficult personal circumstances?
5. Think again of the people in your life who are still in their sin and need Christ. Make a list for the group and pray for each other in your mission to proclaim Christ to them.
6. Learning a bit of Latin in this series was cool but share one more thing that you found personally impactful about the three messages in the *Made for More* series.
