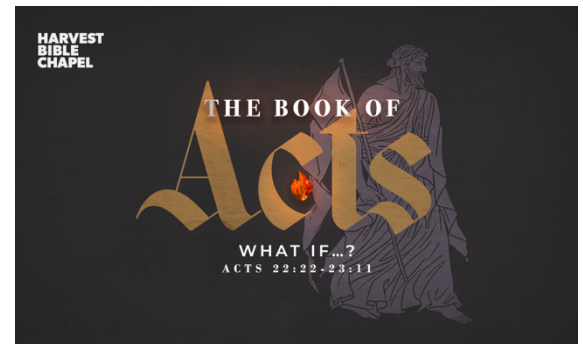

Life Group Questions / November 23

Acts 22:22-23:11

3. Recount the story of someone you know who faced persecution or a difficult trial and who remained measured in their response and demonstrated their determination to live for Christ?
4. How can we help one another “take courage” (23:11) as we face hardship? What do we need to do as individual believers and Life Groups to exemplify the gospel toward others? Make a plan as a group to take something on to do just that.
