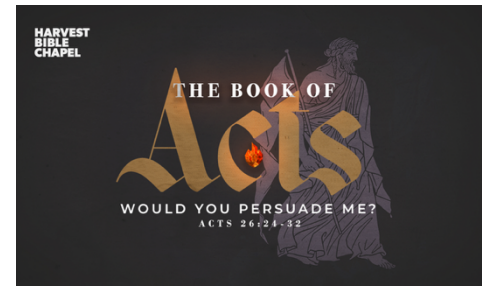

The Book of Acts

67 – Would You Persuade Me?

Acts 26:24-32



1. The Aesop's Fable at the start of the message had this as its moral: "Gentleness and kind persuasion win where force and bluster fail." Share an experience you may have had where this was true.
2. Review what was said about boldness. It is not brashness or belligerence but bravery to speak with confidence. Why do Christians lack boldness and therefore shrink back from sharing their faith?
3. How do some believers "soft sell" the gospel, making it more acceptable to unbelievers? Why do they do that?
4. Review the five verses of the Romans Road to explain the gospel:

5. Being heartfelt or sincere in our presentation of the gospel and in living the Christian life is essential if skeptics are to be brought to Christ. What can we do to be more reasonable (considerate, kind, and gracious)? How can we keep from bullying or pushiness?
