GROUP DISCUSSION

1. Why does loving our enemies feel so unthinkable to us and to the world? How will recognizing God's mercy toward us reshape the way we see the call to love?
2. Why do we often turn love into something self-serving (i.e. looking to profit, hoping to be recognized, wanting to be loved in return, etc.)?
3. What does Christ's sacrificial love teach us about the cost of real love?
4. What might it look like this week to intentionally show Christ's love to someone you typically struggle to love?
5. How does loving our enemies actually point people back to God, and why is that important?
