NOTICE OF NOMINATION

Public Notice is given to the electors of the City of Parksville that nominations for the office of:
Mayor [1]
and
Councillors [6]

will be received by the Chief Election Officer or a designated person, from **9 am on Tuesday, September 1, 2026, to 4 pm on Friday, September 11, 2026**, (excluding statutory holidays and weekends) as follows:

- › by hand at the City of Parksville offices, 100 Jensen Avenue East, Parksville, BC (*appointments are recommended*)
- › by mail, or other delivery services, to the City of Parksville, 100 Jensen Avenue East, Box 1390, Parksville, BC V9P 2H3
- › by fax to 250 248-6650
- › by email to election-official@parksville.ca

Nomination documents are available now from the Chief or Deputy Chief Election Officer at the City of Parksville, Civic and Technology Centre, 100 Jensen Avenue East, Parksville, BC during regular office hours between 8 am and 4 pm, Monday to Friday (excluding weekends and statutory holidays) to the close of the nomination period.

QUALIFICATIONS FOR OFFICE

A person is qualified to be nominated, elected and to hold office as a member of local government if they meet the following criteria:

- › Canadian citizen;
- › 18 years of age or older on general voting day;
- › resident of British Columbia for at least 6 months immediately before the day nomination papers are filed;
- › not disqualified by the *Local Government Act* or any other enactment from voting in an election in British Columbia or from being nominated for, being elected to, or holding office.

Note: There is no requirement for a candidate to be a resident or own property in the municipality.
