

SCOTT, Claude Douglas

Claude Douglas Scott emigrated to Canada from England. The 1911 Canadian Census includes Scott as aged 20, bachelor, a soldier in the barracks in Winnipeg City, Manitoba.

Records indicate he served five years in the North West Mounted Police (Strathcona's Horse) and enlisted in 32nd Battalion of the Canadian Infantry (Manitoba Dragoons) and promoted to Sergeant. On November 30, 1915, Scott died of pneumonia in London, while working on the staff of the Canadian Pay office without seeing any service at the front. He is buried in Grave 173 8 of the Churchyard of All Saints, Kensal Green, London.

Claude Douglas Scott had seven brothers, all of whom served in the war and survived.
