Meeting/Event Code of Conduct

The Events Industry Council, through its member organizations has offered guidelines:

Before Leaving Home

- Evaluate your own health and those of people you are in close contact with; contact the meeting/event organizers if you have concerns.

On-Site During the Convention

- Agree to have your temperature taken before entering the meeting/event venue, if required by the event organizers.
- Agree to wear a mask or facial covering, if required by the event organizers.
- Adhere to social distance protocols put in place by the event organizers and respect others' personal space.
- Go to a local health facility at any time, if you feel unwell or are experiencing flu-like symptoms.

Post-event
