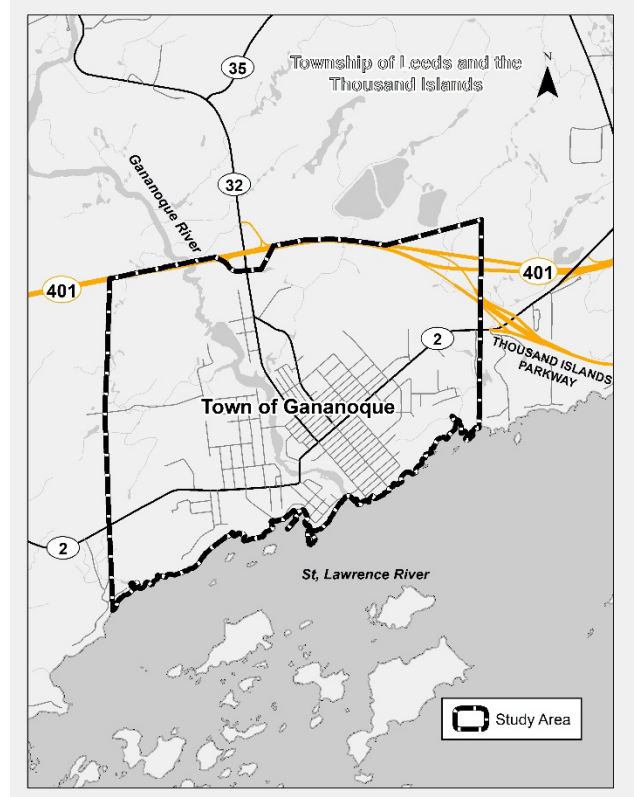
Stakeholders will have the opportunity to review materials and updates throughout the Study on the Town website: www.gananoque.ca.
