The Gananoque Curling Club is excited to have a great lineup of Curling Events coming to our facility in the mid winter and early spring running January 2027 through to May 2027.

While there will be numerous curling activities and events throughout the mid winter/ early spring, there are 8 significant events booked at this time that will attract out of town tourists (curlers) to Gananoque. It is expected that those involved in these events from out of town, will stay minimum of 1 night in local motels, dine in local establishment and shop at our local retailers.

Would like to make special mention of an event we had during a period of Intake #1, we made no submissions. Would like to note an event that we housed Friday September 4th, Saturday September 5th and Sunday September 6th, 2027. The event was a group of 100 people from Montreal and Ottawa, that stayed in Gananoque for 3 nights. There was a group of Bayou Swing Band Dancers. The only meal the Curling provided was a dinner Friday night, so all restaurants, and retailers would've had support from this group throughout the entire weekend. I just received confirmation, this will be an Annual event in Gananoque, and they have booked for 2027.

Aside from these events, we are holding many other events throughout this time, that will attract people to Gananoque, but not likely spending the night in a motel, but will spend in restaurants, and shop at retailers during the day.

We have many league curlers that play throughout the week that support our restaurants and stores on a weekly basis. Just this alone would be 100 people weekly supporting the Town.

These events will have a positive economic impact, not only to the curling club, but to many local businesses during the off-season and providing Winter Tourism
