The South Alley Holiday Market is a one-night community event taking place on Saturday, November 15, from 3:00 – 8:00 PM in Gananoque. The market transforms South Alley into a festive pedestrian corridor featuring more than 45 local artists, makers, and food vendors. The event highlights local entrepreneurship, encourages shop-local spending, and draws significant off-season tourism to the downtown core.

Since its inception, the South Alley Holiday Market has attracted several thousand visitors annually, generating meaningful economic impact for local restaurants, retailers, and accommodations during the low-traffic shoulder season. The event also fosters strong community engagement through children's activities, live entertainment, food trucks, and a food bank collection drive, aligning with the Town's priorities of cultural vibrancy, community well-being, and economic development.

Admission to the event is free, ensuring accessibility for all residents and visitors. It is organized and operated entirely by local volunteers and small business owners. TAP funding will assist in covering unanticipated expenses, including the new provincial requirement for municipal staff to install and remove street barricades for road safety.

Support from the Town of Gananoque will ensure the continued success of this established event, which has become a regional draw and a source of pride for the community. The South Alley Holiday Market contributes directly to the Town's tourism and cultural goals by extending the visitor season, supporting local businesses, and showcasing Gananoque as a welcoming and vibrant destination during the holidays.
