

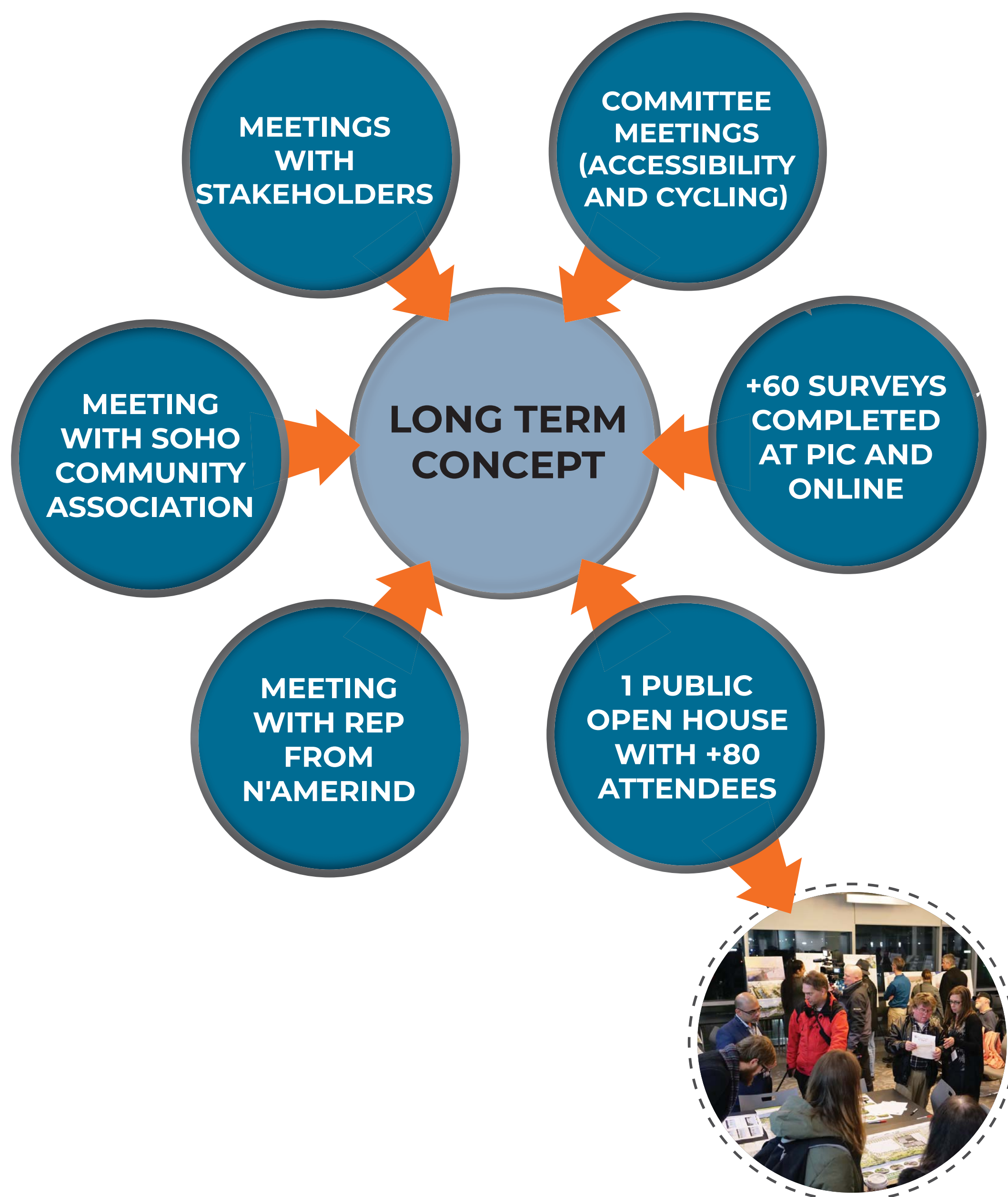
# Public Engagement Feedback

## PUBLIC ENGAGEMENT SUMMARY

In November 2018, The City of London held the first Community Open House with over 80 attendants from the community. We also received 60 completed questionnaires and plenty of online input to help refine the proposal.

This open house is a follow up for the proposed Thames Valley Parkway and Park project in the SoHo Community.

The graphic below summarizes the Public Engagement done to date.

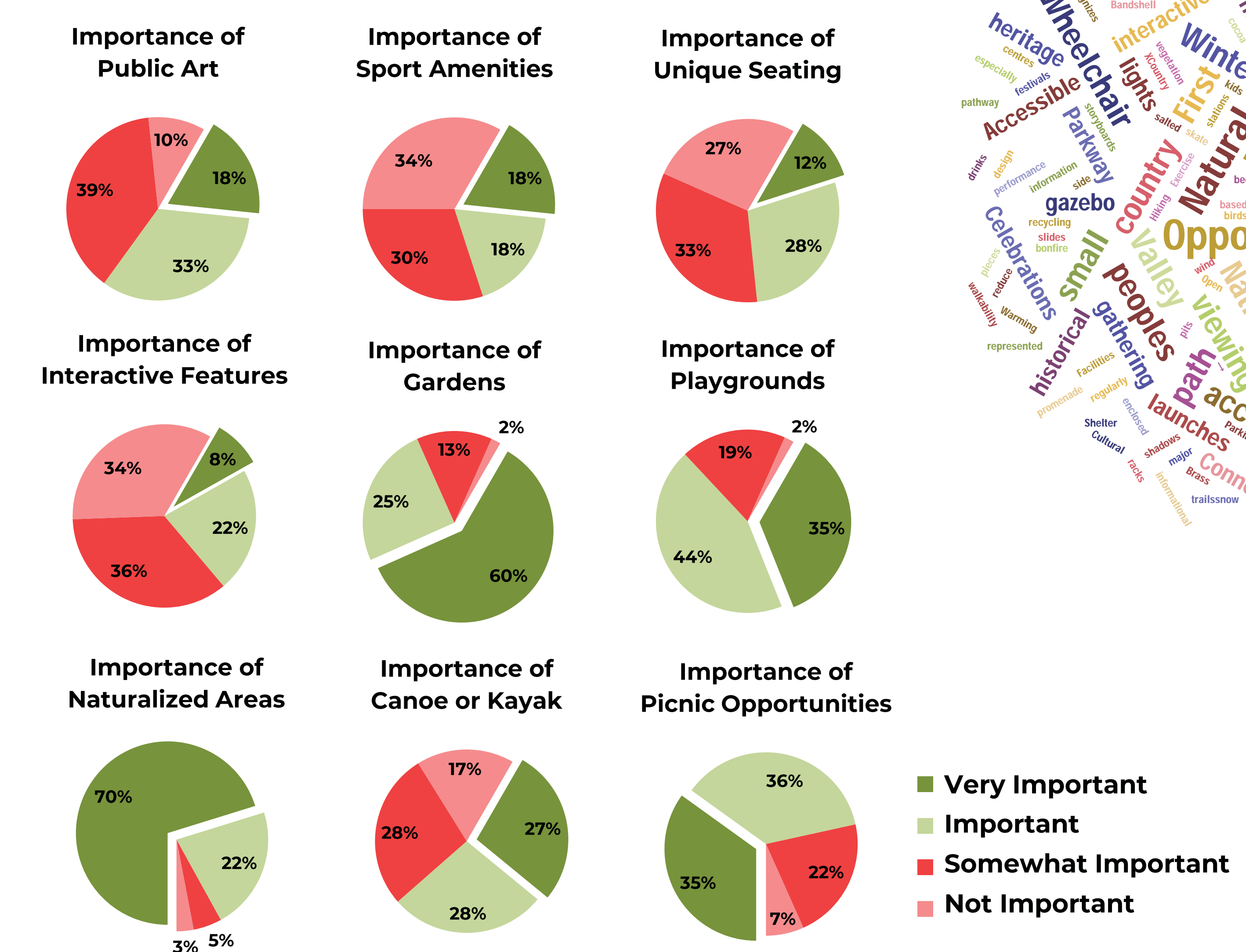


## COMMUNITY FEEDBACK

Thank you to everyone who participated in our first Community Open House or submitted their feedback through the online survey.

The pie charts below summarize the results of the 61 surveys. The results of this survey show significant interest in multi-use trails, public art, naturalization of the environment, integrating more passive activities like picnicking, with less support for active recreation, such as sports fields. And incorporating outdoor gathering spaces for Indigenous ceremonies, cultural events, winter festivals and celebrating the heritage of the site.

## WORD CLOUD

From the Online Survey, 61 written comments were provided. The comments were organized into different key words or phrases which were used to make the word cloud below. A word cloud helps to graphically depict written text. The more frequent a key word or phrase is repeated, the larger the word. The word cloud generated helps illustrate the concepts or activities most frequently mentioned in the written comments.
