COST SUMMARY

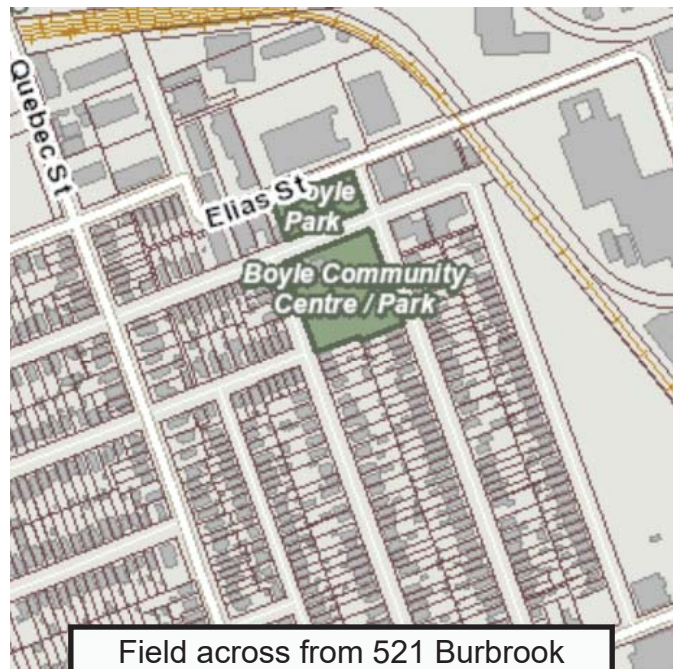
Total Cost = \$9,000

Cost Breakdown:

4 Beehive Woodenware and Equipment and Nucleus Colonies - \$3,000; Tools and materials to run workshops with 8 participants - \$1,800; Apiary Beautification, Gardens and Signage - \$4,200

The LOLA Bees project will celebrate and further our city's interest in honey bees, natural beekeeping and pollinator protection, and will create accessible and hands-on opportunities for community learning! From hosting a hive painting party to launch the 2020 beekeeping season, to creating a beautified apiary with attractive native plant gardens and learning spaces, to coordinating unique hands-on beekeeping workshops, LOLA Bees will allow Londoners to safely experience the remarkable world of honey bees. The LOLA Bees project will increase the vibrancy and environmental stewardship of our Old East Village neighbourhood!

Total Cost = \$6,000

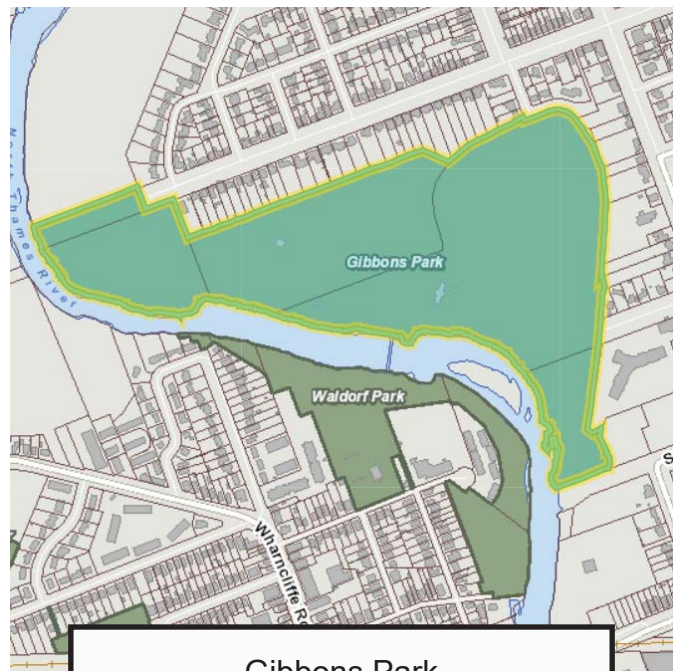
Cost Breakdown:

IDEA SUMMARY

The Richmond Street underpass will be transformed from an uninviting space to a community gateway that invites contemplation and celebration on the themes of belonging, social inclusion and community integration. Led by a professional artist, the project will involve over 100 people participating in a series of facilitated workshops.

COST SUMMARY

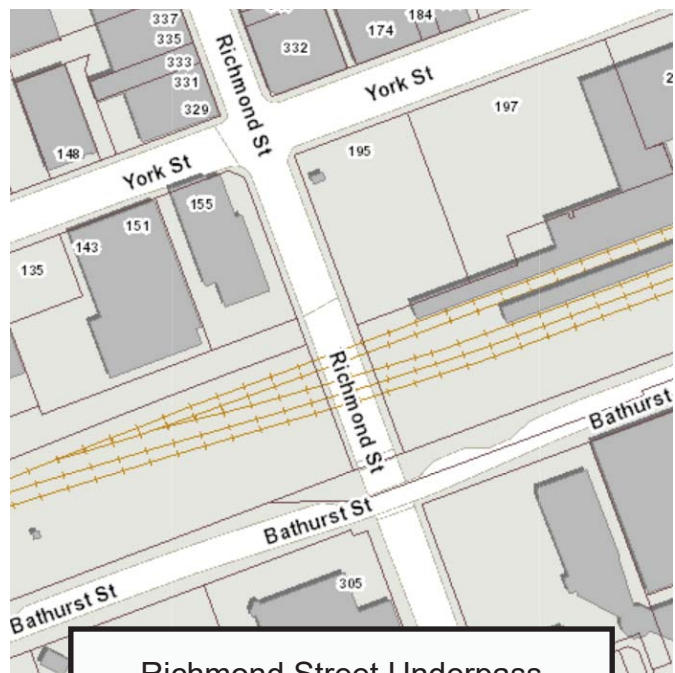
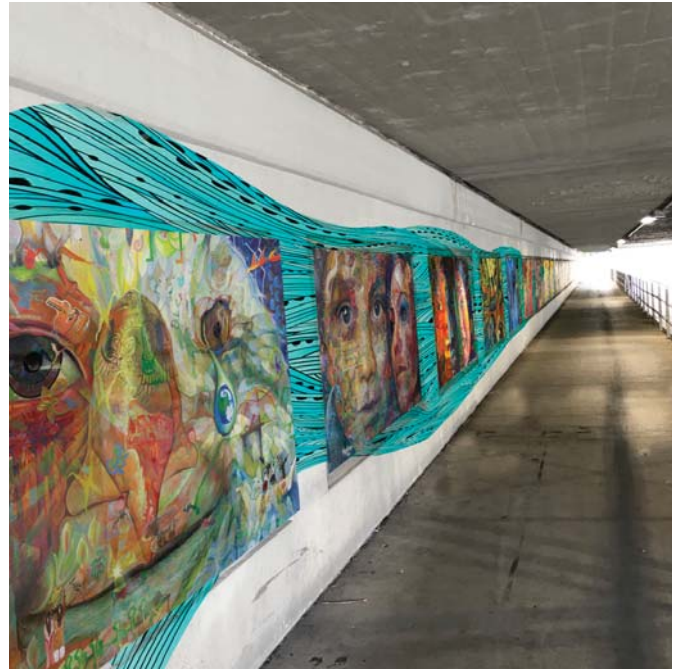
Total Cost = \$30,000

Cost Breakdown:

Materials - \$3,000; Artist Fee - \$4,200; Admin Fee - \$4,200; Community engagement facilitation Costs - \$14,400; Other - \$4,200

COMMUNITY IMPACT

The mural will enliven an important gateway to the City of London. The route is used by people who work and study downtown, families going to festivals and downtown events, international students who attend London International Academy, youth attending Youth Opportunities Unlimited (YOU) programs, and many others.

Total Cost = \$5,000

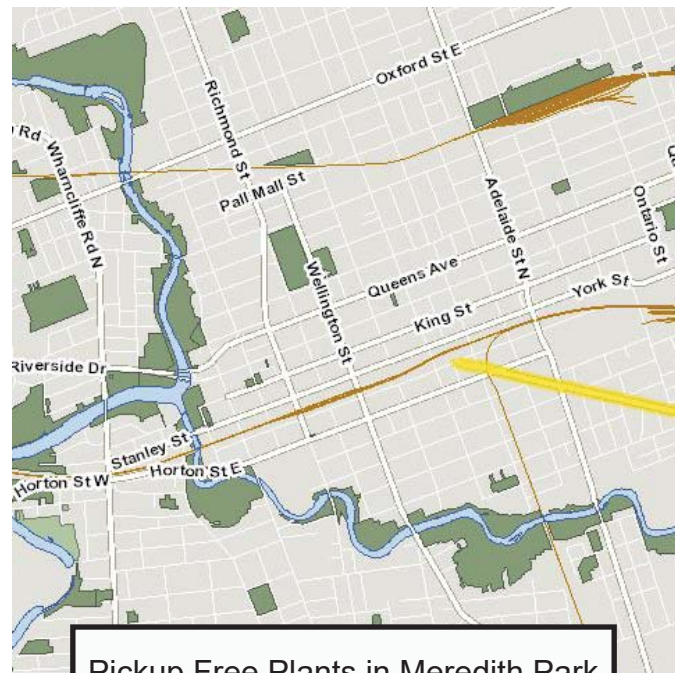
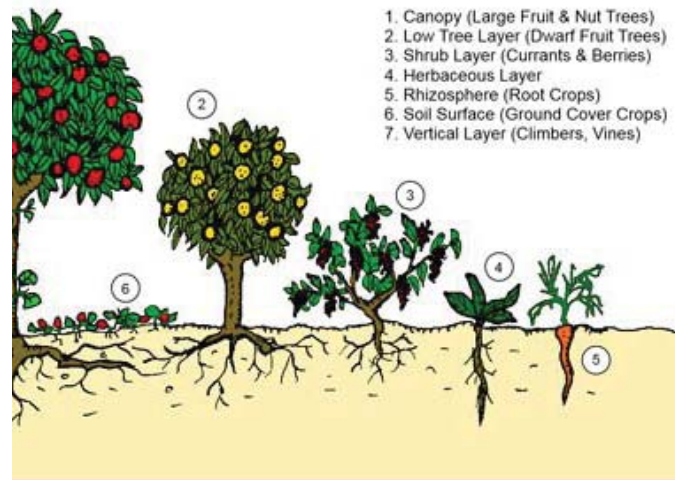
Cost Breakdown:

90 fruit trees, 42 fruit shrubs, 50 raspberries, 7 rhubarb, 12 grape vines, 12 hardy kiwi vines (total of 14 varieties of fruit plant species) - \$5,000
