

Notice of Commencement of Environmental Assessment of the Proposed W12A Landfill Expansion, City of London

The City of London (the City) is beginning an environmental assessment under the *Environmental Assessment (EA) Act* for a proposed landfill expansion.

What is Being Proposed?

The City's existing landfill (W12A) is expected to reach its approved capacity in 2024. It is proposed to expand the W12A Landfill by approximately 13.6 million cubic metres to extend its life to 2049 and increase the service area to a regional area, which includes: the City of London, County of Huron, County of Perth, County of Elgin, County of Lambton, and County of Middlesex. The landfill expansion will occur within the area on and adjacent to the existing landfill property as shown on the map below.



The Process

On July 30, 2019, the Minister of the Environment, Conservation and Parks (MECP) approved the amended terms of reference for the proposed W12A Landfill Expansion. A copy of the approved amended terms of reference is available at: getinvolved.london.ca/WhyWasteDisposal
