A BYLAW OF THE COUNTY OF ST. PAUL NO. 19, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, TO RESCIND UNDEVELOPED LICENSE ROAD ALLOWANCE BYLAW THAT IS NO LONGER REQUIRED BY THE APPLICANTS.
