5.5 Mowing and Spraying Maps

Discussion regarding the Mowing and Spraying schedules within the County:

- Maps to be sent out earlier next year.
- Should moving main arteries be a priority for next year, and not necessarily the smaller trails.
- To be brought to levels of service discussions
- Do we need to add in our policy, legality with spraying on private property, past the fence lines by 6 inches or a foot? In current contract it states to the fence.
- Need to look into current Brushing and Back sloping agreements and amend to allow for over spraying.
- Do we spray every year, or three/four-year rotations, if there is a need, we spray before the rotation, with all roads being checked annually.

 After brushing in the winter, do the roads need to be sprayed for 2 consecutive years.

7.1 Federal Fertilizer Targets

- Federal Dugout testing is being done in Saskatchewan, farmers have been reporting that federal vehicles were entering private land and want to know why? What is the Federal Government testing for?

7.2 Noxious Weeds

Discussion regarding noxious weeds:

- There is a plan/process in place for noxious weeds and weed notices
- Possible list for next meeting of the prohibited noxious weeds to communicate and educate the public, however a list of noxious weeds is already available on the County website

8.1 Agricultural Fieldman Report

Keith Kornelsen presented the following:

- Roadside spraying is finished in all divisions except Division 6, with spot spraying continuing for thistle.
- Roadside mowers are now mowing Division 5 and 6.
- 384 Beavers have been harvested under the Beaver Reduction Program, with 200 trapped by staff.
- Clubroot in four (4) fields currently found, with still more surveying to be completed
- Weed notice given to landowner south of Elk Point Airport
