3. The Landowner represents that he/she is the owner of the adjacent land and agrees to indemnify and save harmless the County in respect of any claims or demands which may at any time hereafter be brought against the County or any employee of the County performing the said work by any person, firm, or corporation because of the performance of the said work.
4. This agreement only applies to the Municipal Reserve or Environmental Reserve lands listed on this agreement.
