



Let's Talk
about
Demolition
Materials

! Larger amounts of demolition material are accepted at Ashmont and Mallaig Transfer Stations. Only a minimum amount is accepted at the other locations.

! Any type of hazardous material and any material that contains asbestos are not accepted.

Do I need a Demolition Permit? Yes. A Building Demolition Permit must first be approved by the County. In addition, a Hazardous Waste or Hazardous Substances Certificate must be provided to the County which clears the demolition materials of any hazardous material or asbestos.

The permit application and certificate are available on the County website under 'Waste Management'.

What are acceptable demolition materials?

These include but are not limited to wood, concrete, siding, shingles, drywall, insulation, glass and ceramic materials.

Can all of these materials be disposed of at the same spot at the transfer stations?

Shingles must be kept separate from other demolition materials.

Clean wood that does not have any paint, wood preservatives or paint can be burnt in the burn pits.

Any recyclable materials must not be dumped in the same place as the demolition materials.

Scrap metal, appliances, electronics, cans of paint, light fixtures with ballasts, light bulbs and any household hazardous waste must be kept separate and sorted accordingly.

How do I know if I have any hazardous materials or asbestos in my demolition project?

A reputable building inspector can inspect your demolition project and confirm whether you have any hazardous materials or asbestos present.

Is there a cost to bringing demolition materials to a transfer station?

Solid waste fees vary from \$55 for a half ton load to \$275 for a 20 yard truck. If the load comes in as a mixed load, the fee goes up to \$110 for a half ton load to \$550 for a 20 yard truck. By sorting materials accordingly, you can save money. The fees can be found on the County's website.
