- ! To avoid the hassle of selling items, you can bring items to Take It or Leave It areas that are located at the County of St. Paul Transfer Stations.
- ! The items dropped off at the areas not for resale but may be usable by someone else ... for free.
- ! See great items left by others that might work for you!

Why do the Transfer Stations have Take it or Leave it areas?

We live in a throw away society. When we have outgrown or just quit using items, we have a tendency to throw things away.

Often, these items end up in landfills that are expensive to build and are becoming less popular from an environmental perspective. By diverting unwanted items, we take another step in helping to preserve our environment.



Take it or Leave it Areas are good for the environment and for your wallet!

Leaving items in the designated area recognizes that some items that we no longer use may be usable by someone else.

Taking care of our environment involves more than just recycling items - such as bottles and cans, tires, paint and used oil - that can be remade into other products.

What can be dropped off?

Used items that can be reused or easily fixed can be dropped off. Items left must be clean and in reasonably good condition.



The following items are not accepted:

baby walkers, bedding, box springs, carpets, car seats, clothes dryers, clothing, cribs, dishwashers, food items, freezers, hot water tanks, humidifiers/de-humidifiers, linoleum, mattresses, microwaves, refrigerators, shoes, stoves, washing machines, televisions or similar appliances.

No Personal Protective Equipment including but not limited to helmets, hard hats, safety boots, masks, or life jackets.

* The Site Attendant shall have final discretion regarding which items are acceptable. Items may be refused for any reason.
