



This Weed and Brush Control Agreement is intended to establish a proactive management plan in collaboration with Agricultural Service Board staff to effectively reduce weeds and brush within the County's right-of-way (ROW). Agreements must be submitted in person at the Public Works Building (5618 57 St, St. Paul) for review and approval by the Agriculture and Waste Supervisor or Foreman. Part 2: Acknowledgement

I acknowledge my duty to maintain the portion of the roadside right-of-way that lies between the boundary of my property and the center line of the road allowance, free from all encroaching brush, noxious and prohibited noxious weeds.

I understand that if any encroaching brush, noxious or prohibited noxious weeds persist within the County of St. Paul No. 19 right-of-way and are determined by the Agricultural Fieldman or their designee to be unacceptable, then the owner/occupant of the adjacent "Weed and Brush Control" area will have until the <u>1st of July</u> to control the right-of-way. It will be up the landowner to contact the County to arrange for other means (Agricultural Services 780-645-3006). Failing to meet an acceptable level of control, the County of St. Paul No. 19 may take whatever steps it deems appropriate to control, which may include herbicide application.

I understand that the County of St. Paul No. 19 right-of-ways shall not be used as a non-pesticide buffer zone. Yards and environmentally sensitive areas will not be sprayed. Spraying will follow the Environmental code of practices for pesticides.

"No Spray" signs must be posted adjacent to the requested "No Spray" area or located at the corners of the property on the property line adjacent to the County roadway by April 30th by the owner or occupant to ensure the property is not sprayed. The County will provide the signs to be posted at no charge to the resident. The owner or occupant is responsible to repair, replace, and display the signs in a visible location from the roadway in collaboration with the Agricultural Services Department. If no signs are posted, the land may be sprayed.

It is the responsibility of the owner or occupant to ensure clear visibility of the signs from the road during the months of May through October and further, to inform the County of St. Paul Agricultural Services Department annually of their intentions regarding continued participation prior to April 30, or at any time that there is a change in property ownership or occupancy.

This Agreement must be signed before April 30 of every year to ensure no spraying is done by the property as per the County of St. Paul's Do Not Spray Policy (ASB-10).
