

County of St. Paul No. 19 ASB Beaver Reduction Incentive Program Program Rules and Application Form



This program supports the lawful removal of beavers impacting County infrastructure in accordance with the ASB-14 Beaver Reduction Incentive Program Policy.

Program Rules

- 1) Eligible applicants must be County of St. Paul landowners or occupants, or residents with written permission from the landowner or occupant.
- 2) Applicants must pre-register and have the application approved by the Agricultural Fieldman or their designate for the specific location at least five business days before any animals are submitted for payment.
- 3) Approval is limited to locations where a verifiable beaver population is causing or is likely to cause damage to County infrastructure, including roads, culverts, bridges, approaches, or drainage works.
- 4) Approval applies only to the location identified on the application. Beavers removed from other locations do not qualify.
- 5) Program dates for 2026 are April 15 to June 30 and September 1 to October 31, or until the Council-approved budget is exhausted.
- 6) Claims are limited to the number of beavers approved per location.
- 7) All beavers must be legally harvested in accordance with applicable provincial and federal legislation.
- 8) Only whole, untouched beaver tails will be accepted for reimbursement.
- 9) Beavers removed by applicants employed as County trappers, do not qualify.
