

BYLAW 2026-18

A BYLAW OF THE COUNTY OF ST. PAUL IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA TO ESTABLISH AN OMNIBUS BYLAW.

Whereas, it is the desire of the municipality to ensure accurate representation of recently enacted legislation in a timely, efficient manner;

Now, Therefore, under the authority and subject to the provisions of the Municipal Government Act, RSA 2000, as amended, the Council of the County of St. Paul No. 19, hereby assembled, enacts the Omnibus Bylaw 2026-18 as follows:

1. Authorizing the implementation of minor, non-substantive amendments to various bylaws, policies, and procedures to ensure accuracy, consistency, and alignment with recently enacted legislation. Amendments may include:
 - a. correction of clerical, grammatical, or typographical errors;
 - b. correction of cross-references, numbering, headings, or formatting;
 - c. updating terminology to reflect new legislation;
 - d. resolving internal inconsistencies or ambiguities;
 - e. removing obsolete provisions;
 - f. other changes of an uncontroversial and uncomplicated nature that do not affect the meaning or application of the bylaw.
2. Nothing in this Bylaw authorizes changes that alter the intent, scope, rights, obligations, or substantive effect of any bylaw, policy, or procedure.
3. Any amendment that may reasonably be interpreted as substantive must be brought forward in a separate amending bylaw, policy, or procedure.
4. Council will be notified electronically of any amendments made within the scope of the Omnibus Bylaw.
