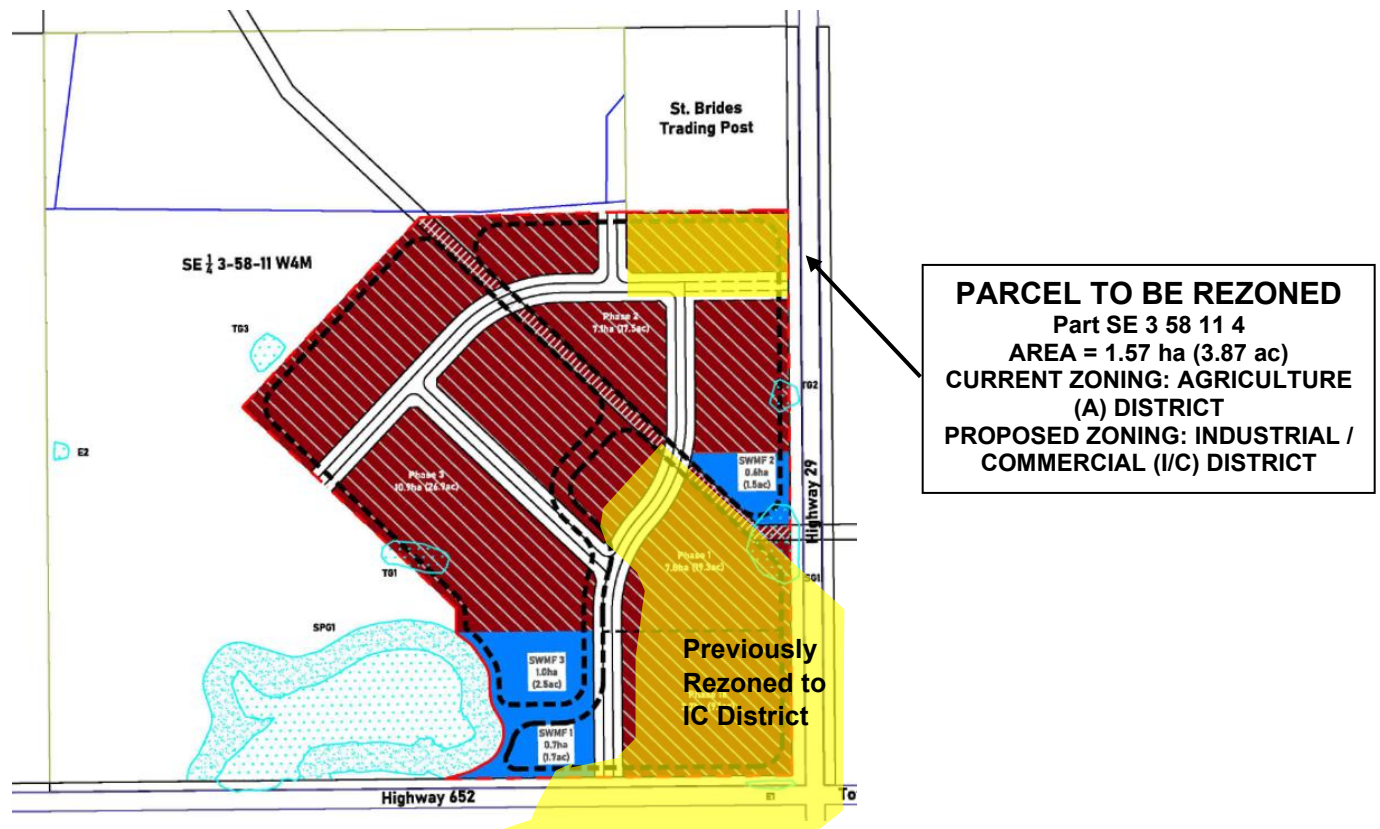


**A BYLAW OF THE COUNTY OF ST. PAUL IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA TO
AMEND THE LAND USE BYLAW 2021-13.**

Now, Therefore, under the authority and subject to the provisions of the Municipal Government Act, 2000, as amended, and by virtue of all other powers enabling it, the Council of the County of St. Paul No. 19, hereby assembled, enacts as follows:

1. FROM: The Agriculture (A) District to the Industrial / Commercial District
FOR: Part SE 3 58 11 W4, as shown on the sketch below



2. Part 1.3 Definitions, is amended to insert the following definition in alphabetical and numerical order:
- “funeral home”** means a facility which provides for the arrangement of funerals, the holding of funeral services and the preparation of the deceased person for burial or cremation. This use does not include a Crematorium.

3. Part 8.7 Industrial /Commercial (IC) District, Subsection (3) is deleted and replaced with the following:

(3) Discretionary Uses:

- a. Amusement Establishments, Indoor
- b. Amusement Establishments, Outdoor
- c. Auto Wrecker
- d. Bingo Halls
- e. Buildings and Uses Accessory to Discretionary Uses
- f. Cannabis Production Facility
- g. Cannabis Retail Establishment
- h. Funeral Home
- i. Gambling Machine Establishments
- j. Hotels
- k. Industrial, Heavy
- l. Industrial, Medium
- m. Intensive Agriculture
- n. Liquor Stores
- o. Mini Storage with or without outside storage areas
- p. Motels
- q. Natural Resource Extraction and Processing
- r. Stockpiling of Aggregate for Sale
- s. Surveillance Suites
- t. Veterinary Clinics
- u. Work Camps
