

BYLAW 2026-16

A BYLAW OF THE COUNTY OF ST. PAUL IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA TO AMEND THE LAND USE BYLAW No. 2021-13.

Whereas, Section 35(29) of Bylaw 2021-13, the Land Use Bylaw states the method by which the setback from a Wind Energy Conversion System (WECS) is calculated;

And Whereas Council desires to amend Section 35(29) of the Land Use Bylaw so that the setback is based upon a fixed number rather than a calculation;

Now, Therefore, under the authority and subject to the provisions of the Municipal Government Act, RSA 2000, as amended, the Council of the County of St. Paul No. 19, hereby assembled, enacts amendments to the Land Use Bylaw No. 2021-13 as follows:

1. Existing Section 7.35.(29) is deleted and replaced with

“The setback distance between a WECS and a dwelling, within or outside the project boundary, shall be 1,500 m.”

Read a second time in Council this 28th day of July A.D. 2026.
