

BYLAW 819/19
TOWN OF ELK POINT #043

BEING A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF ELK POINT, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, TO ADOPT THE TOWN OF ELK POINT AND COUNTY OF ST. PAUL NO. 19 INTERMUNICIPAL DEVELOPMENT PLAN.

WHEREAS, Section 631(1) of the Municipal Government Act, being Chapter M-26 of the Statutes of Alberta, provides that two or more Councils may, by each passing a Bylaw, adopt an Intermunicipal Development Plan;

AND WHEREAS, Council deems it desirable to adopt an Intermunicipal Development Plan with the County of St. Paul No. 19;

AND WHEREAS, Council recognizes that the lands contained within the Intermunicipal Development Plan will remain under the jurisdiction of the County of St. Paul No. 19, and that the Intermunicipal Development Plan provides a basis for cooperation and communication on matters of mutual interest;

AND WHEREAS, notice of the proposed Bylaw and Public Hearing was given pursuant to Section 606(2) of the Municipal Government Act, being Chapter M-26 of the Statutes of Alberta;



NOW THEREFORE, the Municipal Council of the Town of Elk Point duly assembled enacts as follows:

That the Town of Elk Point and County of St. Paul No. 19 Intermunicipal Development Plan, as attached and forming part of this Bylaw, be adopted.

Bylaw #705/12 be and is hereby repealed.

READ a FIRST time in Council this 8th day of July, A.D. 2019.




