

Public Notice – Highway Paving

Alberta Department of Highways owns and maintains Highway 41, including part of the Highway that runs through the Town of Elk Point.

Department of Highways has recently completed a 50mm asphalt concrete pavement overlay from South of the North Saskatchewan River to the junction of Highway 28. These pavement overlays are used to extend pavement life by improving surface roughness and driver comfort.

The section through Elk Point would require pavement milling to tie into the existing curb and gutter, manholes, and water valves, and pavement milling was not a part of this recent overlay.

Department of Highways will continue to monitor and maintain Highway 41. Pavement milling and a full-depth overlay, will be considered in Elk Point in the future when conditions warrant.
