POLICY STATEMENT

1. The Fishing Lake Settlement would like to provide members and their children opportunities to make a commitment to recreational activities of their choosing. The funding comes from an agreement with Canadian Natural Resources Ltd.

2. Eligible Activities

- a) Lessons of Artistic Nature such as: Music, Art, Dance.
- b) Registration or Monthly fees for sports that do not have a defined season.
- c) Ongoing costs for sports: Martial Arts, Boxing, Swimming, and Cheer.
- d) The Eligibility for one-time sports such as Hockey, Football, Baseball, Soccer and or clinics and costs associated with tryouts.
- e) Equipment needed for sports. (One-time equipment purchases)
- f) Conference & Workshop fees for Culture, Arts, Women, Men, etc.

3. SPONSORSHIP

- a) The sponsorship grant will be \$5,000.00 per individual per fiscal year.
- b) the Administrator or Administrators designate are responsible for the administration of this policy.

4. ACCESS

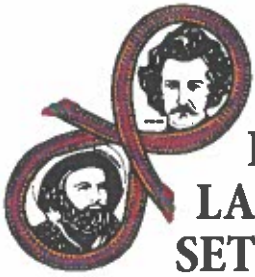
An individual applying for sponsorship must:

- a) Be a member or a child of a member of the Fishing Lake Settlement.
- b) Provide proof of said sponsorship, for example registration fee form.
- c) Apply for sponsorship at least one week in advance of the date the funds are required.
- d) Fees will be paid directly to the Organization.
- e) Misuse of funds will result in a reimbursement of funds requested.
