

Lakeland College Fall Semester CIC Indigenous Bursary

Applications must be received in the Financial Aid & Awards Office by July 31 for fall term only (5 awards valued at \$2,500 per semester).

The **Crown Investments Corporation of Saskatchewan (CIC)** has a partnership funding agreement with Lakeland College in support of the CIC Indigenous Bursary. The intent is to provide financial aid to Indigenous students in support of their educational goals and to support and build a skilled and inclusive labour force in Saskatchewan. The bursary reflects the commitment of CIC and the Government of Saskatchewan to respond to the Truth and Reconciliation Commission's Call to Action 92(b) which calls for the promotion of equitable access to jobs, training and education opportunities for Indigenous peoples in the corporate sector and support for Indigenous communities to gain sustainable benefits from economic development projects.

To be eligible for this entrance bursary, applicants must:

- Be of self-declared Indigenous ancestry (includes Status First Nation, Non-Status First Nation, Métis or Inuit).
- Be admitted and enrolled full-time in the first year of a Lakeland College designated program, 16 weeks or more in length, offered on-campus, through distance, delivery, or a combination of on-campus and distance delivery.
- Have been a resident of Saskatchewan during the past 12 months.
- Have completed their last high school grade with a minimum 65% average.
- Based on financial need (60% weighting), and community and/or campus involvement (40% weighting).



Eligibility

To be eligible for this continuing bursary, applicants must:

- Be of self-declared Indigenous ancestry (includes Status First Nation, Non-Status First Nation, Métis or Inuit).
- Be admitted and enrolled full-time in the second year of any Lakeland College designated program, 16 weeks or more in length, offered on-campus, through distance delivery, or a combination of on-campus and distance delivery.
- Have been a resident of Saskatchewan during the past 12 months.
- Have completed their first year of a two-year Lakeland College program with a minimum 65% average for all classes (GPA of 2.0).
- Based on financial need (60% weighting), and community and/or campus involvement 40% weighting).

Additional conditions:

Preference given to students in the designated Business, Trades and Technology, and Environmental Science programs. A complete listing of those programs is available on the Lakeland College website at: lakelandcollege.ca/awards. If there are funds available after awarding to students from preferred programs, a student from another program who meets all the other bursary requirements will be considered.

This award is not currently available with respect to Lakeland College programs brokered to other institutions.

The bursaries will be paid out in two instalments, one upon confirmation of full-time enrolment in semester one and the second upon confirmation of full-time enrolment in semester two. Recipients must continue to be enrolled full-time and have met the Lakeland College requirements for attendance and academic performance to be eligible to receive the second instalment of their bursary.

CIC Bursary Application INSTRUCTIONS

- Complete all sections. Only complete applications will be considered. A new competition is held each year. Previous recipients should ensure Section 3 is filled out completely, as information from previous applications is not reviewed.
- Enclose a transcript of grades from any post-secondary institution attended (other than Lakeland College) or from high school if you have not completed any post-secondary classes.
- Completed applications must be submitted to the Financial Aid & Awards Office, Lakeland College, Vermilion Campus, 5707 College Drive, Vermilion, AB T9X 1K5 or financialaid@lakelandcollege.ca by **midnight July 31** in order to be considered.
