Tax rate \rightarrow

The tax rate for the year 2021, all Canadian provinces was conducted in Dynacom automatically December 9th 2020.

★ For the tax year 2020, in addition to reporting employment income in Box 14 or Code 71, use <u>new other information codes</u> for periods from March 15 to September 26, 2020.

How to report employment income during COVID-19 pay periods

For the tax year 2020, in addition to reporting employment income in Box 14 or Code 71, use new other information codes when reporting employment income and retroactive payments in the following periods:

- Code 57: Employment income March 15 to May 9
- Code 58: Employment income May 10 to July 4
- Code 59: Employment income July 5 to August 29
- Code 60: Employment income August 30 to September 26


Eligibility criteria for the CERB, CEWS, and CESB is based on employment income for a defined period. The new requirement means employers should report income and any retroactive payments made during these periods.

Example

If you are reporting employment income for the period of April 25 to May 8, payable on May 14, use code 58.

To make it easier for you, Dynacom has provided you with a report allowing you to access the cumulative for each employee by cell. This report allows you to have exact information for each employee.





In addition, the T4 2020 format has been adjusted to take into account the addition of the 4 boxes as well as the calculation of the cumulative amounts associated with each period requested by the government.

PRINCIPAL CHANGES

Changes to the guide's content and structure

We have revised nearly all of the guide's content and changed its structure. In particular, we have replaced Part 4, "Special cases," with the following four parts:

- · Part 4, "Other payments;"
- Part 5, "Other reimbursements;"
- Part 6, "Employees Special cases;"
- Part 7, "Employers Special cases."

These new parts also include certain instructions related to amounts to be entered in boxes of the RL-1 slip that previously appeared in Part 3.

Fees paid to self-employed building service workers

In general, you only need to report fees and other amounts paid to self-employed individuals in box 0 (code RD) of the RL-1 slip if you withheld Québec income tax on these amounts.

However, beginning with the 2020 taxation year, you will have to report fees and other amounts paid to self-employed individuals for building service work performed inside or outside a public building in box 0 (code RD) of the RL-1 slip **even if you do not withhold Québec income tax on these amounts**.

New additional information codes related to benefits paid under a government assistance program to support workers during the COVID-19 pandemic (codes 0-5, 0-6 and 0-7)

The new 0-5, 0-6 and 0-7 additional information codes are to be used exclusively by Revenu Québec or the Government of Canada to identify amounts of benefits paid during the year under a government assistance program to support workers during the COVID-19 pandemic (for example, benefits from the Incentive Program to Retain Essential Workers and the Canada Emergency Response Benefit).

Therefore, these codes must not be entered in the blank boxes of RL-1 slips that you file.

No changes were applied in Dynacom. Only Releve 1 forms have been updated.

Changes to the PROVINCIAL Summary $1 \rightarrow$

There are no changes for 2020 that relate to the Dynacom application.

However, we invite you to consult our procedure on the FSS rate.

Postal Code >

The provincial government of Quebec has asked us to remove the possibility of adding a hyphen (-) in the postal code. So for all postal codes in Canada the dash is refused, but



for other countries it will be accepted. You do not have to change your already entered postal codes.
